PINELAND: Located on the west coast of Pine Island, a little to the north of center, Pineland is a small, cozy community of cottages built on ceremonial Calusa Indian mounds, facing out to Pine Island Sound. In the distance, lie Useppa and North Captiva Islands and the Gulf of Mexico. Although a popular marina and daily charters to the out-islands are the major attractions that draw visitors to this off-the-beaten-path community today, it is worth the trip simply for the sheer beauty of its picturesque setting. The view out into Pine Island Sound is breathtaking and the lush tropical foliage, featuring many stately coconut palms and the old gumbo limbo trees, create an especially exotic atmosphere. John L. Lewis, former president of the United Mine Workers, lived for several years on the old indian mounds overlooking Pine Island Sound. It is the Pineland area where you will find many of the famous Pine Island tropical fruit orchards. Pineland was first settled in the 1870s.
